

## Current situation

NT Airports is continuing to monitor the COVID-19 situation. Our priority remains the wellbeing and safety of our staff, contractors, visitors and travellers, and we are taking all the necessary precautions to ensure our people are protected.

## Latest advice

There have been 28 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the Northern Territory. It has been over two weeks since the last confirmed case in the Territory. At this time, there is no community spread of this virus in the Northern Territory. While the situation is currently stable, it is important that we continue to follow the recommended advice to keep it this way and avoid becoming complacent.

## Airport operations

This Sunday 26 April, four Singapore Airlines Airbus A380 will be arriving at Alice Springs Airport to be parked at Asia Pacific Aircraft Storage (APAS) facility. This will be the largest passenger aircraft to land in Alice Springs and is an exciting opportunity for the airport and aviation enthusiasts.

We understand that this is an exciting opportunity for locals however viewing of the aircraft will be limited due to current social distancing requirements and checkpoints in place.

Alice Springs Airport has reduced operating hours and there is restricted access to the terminal.

## Virgin Australia update

As many of you are aware, this week Virgin Australia was placed into voluntary administration. We are in close communication with our airline partner to understand what this means for them and what their plans are. Despite their current situation, they continue to meet their financial obligations and the relationship with our airline partner remains strong.

NT Airports is working with each of our partners to collectively navigate our way through the COVID-19 situation and it is our desire for the airline to remain viable and continue to service the transport needs of Territorians.

## Support for tenants

On 23 April 2020, the Northern Territory Government announced a \$6 million Council Support Package to support councils in offering rates waivers and deferrals for commercial ratepayers facing hardships. NT Airports is continuing to work through the details of all the recently announced packages and will be contacting our tenants to discuss the available relief packages as soon as possible. We encourage all of our tenants to stay in touch with us during this period.
