

Current situation

NT Airports is continuing to monitor the COVID-19 situation. Our priority remains the wellbeing and safety of our staff, contractors, visitors and travellers, and we are taking all the necessary precautions to ensure our people are protected.

Latest advice

There have been 30 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the Northern Territory and all cases have now recovered. It has been more than two weeks since the last confirmed case.

From Friday 15 May, social distancing restrictions began to ease in the Territory as outlined in the Northern Territory Government's Roadmap to the New Normal.

While the situation is currently stable and some restrictions in the Territory are easing, it is important that we continue to follow the recommended advice and avoid becoming complacent.

Airport operations

The Alice Springs Airport 2020 Master Plan Preliminary Draft has been released for public comment. The 2020 Master Plan is a blueprint for Alice Springs Airports' development over the next 20 years and also includes the Airport Environment Strategy.
